THE ACADEMIC PROGRAM REVIEW PROCESS: PHASE 1 AND 2

The purpose of a portfolio review process is to assess each program effectively in a manner that helps inform decisions for adapting our academic portfolio in the context of the financial and workforce conditions we face and the mission of UNCG. Each academic degree program will be assessed, and a range of possibilities will be considered, including discontinuation, reduction, maintenance, and investment for those programs positioned for future expansion. An important component of such assessment is the availability of data reflecting program strength, productivity, operating costs, and other factors deemed relevant. We have been asked to provide a tentative plan for the School of Nursing (SON) to navigate and make decisions related to the Academic Review. The school review period is September 18, 2023, to December 15, 2023.

The School of Nursing will enlist the following tentative plan to make decisions related to the Academic Program Review. The SON Executive Leadership Team is comprised of the dean, associate and assistant deans, department chairs and director of faculty credentialling and compliance for the **Phase 1** Review. The **Phase II** review will be conducted by program directors, concentration coordinators, a faculty assembly co-chair, curriculum committee chair, director of office of student success along with department chairs, assistant dean for budget and administration, and the associate dean for community engagement and academic partnerships.
